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Congratulations on your acceptance to the Elms College Nursing Program!

Please *prepare* to submit the following documentation to PreCheck during the month of July. More information will be sent directly from the School of Nursing on this process.

The college is required to have the following **documentation** on file (verbal or written history of the disease or of receiving the immunizations is **not sufficient**). Required forms are also available on our website.

1. Completed **Report of Medical History** form
2. **Physical Exam** within last 12 months
3. Documentation of **Tdap** vaccine within 10 years
4. Documentation of 2 **MMR** vaccines or lab documentation of immunity to measles, mumps, and rubella
5. Documentation of 2 **varicella** vaccines or lab documentation of immunity to varicella
6. Documentation of 3 **hepatitis B** vaccines or lab documentation of immunity to hepatitis B
7. Completed **Meningitis Waiver** form or documentation of a meningococcal A vaccine within 5 years.  
This is the only vaccine that can be waived
8. **Documentation of an Influenza vaccination** for the current season
9. **Documentation of COVID-19 vaccination series** completion
10. **Documentation of tuberculosis testing** within 12 months from the start of classes (May submit QFT, Tspot, or 2-step Mantoux Testing)  
If positive history, provide CXR report within 5 years, a positive history questionnaire, and treatment documentation, if applicable.
11. **Basic Life Support (BLS)**- CPR through the American Heart Association is the only course accepted. Submit a copy of your card or e-certificate that shows your certificate coverage period.  
The renewal date will be set based on the expiration of your certification.

A one-time urinalysis and an annual CORI/SORI will be coordinated through the School of Nursing.

Documentation must be submitted directly to PreCheck! More information regarding the process of submission will come directly from the School of Nursing in the beginning of July.

Failure to supply the state required documentation will result in a health hold and you will be unable to move into the residence halls, register for or attend classes or clinical.
